All growers and traders must have a Code compliant Horticulture Produce Agreement and the ACCC has the power to enforce civil penalties and infringement notices on both growers and traders.

The only exemptions are if you trade directly with a retailer, processor or exporter.

The new Code has been designed to protect growers but also reflect the flexibilities that need to operate in the market place.

Growcom, along with the regional horticulture bodies, invites you to attend regional free grower specific workshop to help you understand how the Code protects your business and to make sure you meet your obligations.
